As of the Fall 2014 semester, students declaring a French Major need to register for *Senior Inquiry* (FREN 4960) the semester they are scheduled to graduate. All French Majors, regardless of when they declared the Major, are highly encouraged to participate in the *Senior Inquiry* experience as the capstone of their studies in French at Saint Louis University.

This form is completed **2 semesters** prior to your graduation date and submitted to your French Mentor at least by the time that you complete the Graduation checklist. Earlier submissions are highly encouraged.

## Description:

For the **Senior Inquiry** (FREN 4960), students have the option of:

- completing an additional 4000-level course in French (beyond the 30 hours required for the Major),
- or conducting a final research project under the supervision of a French faculty member. Students discuss in advance their proposed research topic with a faculty member whose specialty lies in their area of interest. The project should be a 7-page paper in French, plus a bibliography. Students share their work with other French Majors by giving a short presentation at the Department's Annual Student Symposium, generally held in late March or early April. The Symposium provides a unique experience to their studies in French and the opportunity to interact with other graduating Seniors in French from their class.
