Only freshman may submit work from high school (<u>less</u> than half your submission can be h.s. work). Sophomores-Juniors need to submit work done at the university.

The Studio Art portfolio review process uses SlideRoom, an online review system. Applicants register and submit their portfolio on the SlideRoom website using SLU's portal: https://slu.slideroom.com. SlideRoom is web-based, so all applicants need is an Internet connection and a modern web browser - and applicants with prepared digital files can quickly upload their portfolio within minutes.
