Suggested Timelines for Completion

Below are suggested timelines aimed to help participants complete the Certificate in University Teaching Skills Program. These timelines are *suggestions* and are provided to help participants visualize and plan how they might complete the program requirements.

We have created two possible timelines: Fast-Track Timeline and Standard Timeline. We believe that the Standard Timeline of two years is the optimal length of time for completion of either Certificate; however, it is possible to complete in only one year. Participants can take longer than two years to complete their certificate; however, we encourage participants to complete it within two years so that they can stay active in the program. Extending your time in the program past two years may cause you to forget some experiences or lose track of required materials.
