LL.M. Program for Foreign Lawyers applications are reviewed on a rolling basis, which means the committee reviews each applicant's file once it receives all application materials. Applications for the 2021-2022 academic year should be submitted no later than April 1, 2021 to ensure that visa paperwork can be processed in time for admission in Fall 2021.

We recommend applying by the early application deadline of December 15, 2020. The final application deadline is April 1, 2021.
