Women's Preventive Services – Prescription Contraceptives
January 1, 2013

Effective January 1, 2013, the UHP medical and prescription drug benefits were enhanced in response to passage of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA), as amended. Expansion of these benefits will make it easier for women to receive preventive care without cost sharing. Coverage without cost sharing means women can receive certain preventive services without having to pay a deductible, coinsurance or copayment. While PPACA rules require coverage with no cost sharing for contraceptive services, the IRS, DOL, and HHS have jointly issued guidance that allow for reasonable medical management techniques and benefit designs to control costs.

The University Health Plan will cover most contraceptive prescriptions with no cost share. However, there are Brand contraceptive prescriptions for which members may have to pay an applicable copayment. To minimize out-of-pocket pharmacy costs, members can reference the list below for generic contraceptive prescriptions that will be covered with no cost sharing. Please note that this list is partial and subject to change.
