## **Graduate Student Orientation** **15-60 minutes**

Teaches students how to actively reflect on their first impressions, observations, opinions, and experiences through writing.

## **Thesis Statements** **50 minutes**

Teaches students how to identify, differentiate between, and craft informative statements and argumentative claims.
