**Instructions** – After cleaning and preparing the pumpkin for carving, tape or pin the template to the side of the pumpkin. Using the tip of a knife or a poker tool, make pinpoint marks along the dashed lines. Check to see if transfer of design is complete. (Areas represented in black will be carved out of the pumpkin.) Remove pattern from the pumpkin. Using a serrated knife or pumpkin-carving saw, cut along dashed lines using a sawing motion. Work from the center of the design outward. Saw and remove smallest pieces first.
