

Delta Lambda ($\Delta\Lambda$) Chapter Sigma Theta Tau ($\Sigma\Theta\tau$) International

Criteria

Joan Hrubetz Doctoral Student Award

1. Purpose: To recognize a student in the doctoral program, Saint Louis University School of Nursing for outstanding achievement in the areas of leadership, scholarship, research, and creativity in clinical practice.
2. Funding: To be budgeted by the Finance Committee and approved by the Executive Board.
3. Award Criteria
 - A. Have completed a minimum of 18 credit hours in the doctoral program, exclusive of master degree credits.
 - B. Be an active (per page 2 of Bylaws-a current dues paying member) Delta Lambda Chapter member.
 - C. Demonstrate evidence of commitment to the ideals of Sigma Theta Tau International: leadership, scholarship, research, and creativity.
 - D. Will not have defended the dissertation by the time of the award.
4. Information to be Submitted:
 - A. Official copy of post-baccalaureate transcript(s).
 - B. Two letters of support:
 - a. One letter from a Saint Louis University School of Nursing graduate faculty member.
 - b. One letter from a colleague familiar with the nominee's nursing practice.
 - c. Concise statement from the nominee describing how his/her professional achievements and career goals are consistent with the ideals of Sigma Theta Tau International: leadership, scholarship, research, and creativity.
 - d. The Awards Committee may request additional information.
5. Process:
 - A. Faculty member familiar with the doctoral student will initiate the nomination.
 - B. The faculty member will inform the doctoral student of the nomination, obtain his/her approval to continue the process, and provide the student with the appropriate forms.
 - C. The nominating faculty member will submit one letter of support.
 - D. The doctoral student will request the second letter of support from an individual of his/her choice familiar with the student's nursing practice, and will submit the remaining required documents.
 - E. The Chapter Awards Committee will review the nominations, and the Committee will recommend a recipient to the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee may accept or reject the recommendation.
 - F. The recipient will be notified prior to the Induction Ceremony.
 - G. The Chairperson of the Awards Committee will announce recipient and present award at the Induction Ceremony.
 - H. March 31 deadline for submission of proposals.
