**Janice Hooper Webster University Undergraduate  
Award Nominations**

The Janice Hooper Webster University Undergraduate Award is designed to acknowledge an undergraduate student from the Webster University Department of Nursing who has demonstrated excellence, academically and clinically.

Nominees for this undergraduate award must be Chapter members or be eligible for Chapter membership and enrolled in the undergraduate nursing program at Webster University. Upon acceptance into the chapter, their nomination for an award will be considered with all others. Chapter members and eligible persons, who have graduated since the presentation of the previous year's awards, may also be considered.

To be eligible for award consideration, the nominee must be recommended by two Chapter members, or recommended by one Chapter member and endorsed by a second Chapter member. One of these members must be a Webster University Department of Nursing faculty member who has been involved in the nominee's educational experience.

Selection of the award recipient will be based on the following criteria:

1. A cumulative GPA of 3.50.
2. Demonstrated excellence in four of the following areas:
  - A. Application of theoretical knowledge.
  - B. Provision of holistic and compassionate care.
  - C. Leadership
  - D. Application of nursing research or participation in nursing research.
  - E. Provision of professional, community, or University service

This undergraduate award will be presented to the nominee who best meets the above criteria.
