Deadline for Application: June 9, 2017

To be considered for the Saint Louis University NANDA Scholarship award, master's or post-master's nursing students must be interested in developing or promoting the use of nursing diagnosis and be willing to conduct research, implement a project, or submit an essay related to nursing diagnosis. In addition, students must be in good academic standing at the University and at the School of Nursing and must remain enrolled in the School of Nursing as a nursing student through the academic year.

1. Please fill out the information below.
2. Attach a letter or recommendation from your faculty advisor or coordinator at the School of Nursing.
3. Submit a brief description of the nursing diagnosis research including purpose, background, hypotheses, methodology, data analysis, and implications.
4. Submit a brief description of the nursing diagnosis project including title, purpose, background information, and method of implementation.
5. Submit an original, publishable essay of 10-15 typewritten double spaced pages (include relevant bibliography).
6. Interview may be required with School of Nursing faculty members on the NANDA scholarship committee to discuss nursing diagnosis and the research, project, or essay.
