This year student learning outcomes #5, #6, #7 and #8 were evaluated. Summary of Major findings from the analysis:

In summary, the ABSN option met all of the established benchmarks for Learning Outcomes 5, 6. The options met the established outcomes for Learning Outcome #7 and #8 in all areas except the HESI RN Exit-1 results which indicate benchmarks for AACN Curriculum: Scholarship for Evidence Based Practice and AACN Curriculum: Interprofessional Communication were not met. The course content and assignments for *NURS 2705 Intraprofessional Issues in Evidenced Based Care* will be reviewed with the course faculty this summer to identify ways to improve student mastery of the content for this benchmark.



In summary, the TBSN option met the established benchmarks for Learning Outcomes 5, 6, 7, and 8 with regard to the Clinical Evaluation Tools, EBI/Skyfactor results, and identified projects (Health Care Safety Project and Health Promotion Clinical and Patient Teaching Project). HESI RN Exit results indicate benchmarks met (by either first or second time teasting) for Student Learning Outcomes 5 and 6. However, benchmarks were not met (first or second time testing) on the HESI RN Exit for Student Learning Outcomes 7 and 9.

It should also be noted that the EBI/Skyfactor results and NCLEX first time pass rates reported are from January, 2019 which are the results from last year's graduating class (Cohort 2018). Results from the 2019 graduating cohort will be received in January, 2020.

These results will be discussed with the TBSN option faculty at the Curriculum meeting scheduled for August, 2019.

Some of the LOs are complex, making observability difficult. Many of the outcomes contain multiple knowledge/skills.

Response: Option coordinators have reviewed the learning outcomes and have "unbundled" some of the more complex statements where possible.

- f. A few outcomes are assessed each year; a reasonable cycle ensures meaningful assessment and manageability. (meets standard)
- 4-5 learning outcomes assessed each year, to complete a full cycle in 3 years. Program may need to consider reducing the number of outcomes assessed each year if data becomes unmanageable or not meaningful

Response: This recommendation will be considered after the three-year cycle.

h. Methods of analysis of student achievement data identify learning gaps and possible curricular or pedagogical remedies. ⊠Positive trend evident

Preliminary analysis of benchmarking revealed some areas where the benchmark was not met. The analysis of why the benchmark was not met and what can be done about it is forthcoming. This will be discussed further at the August 2018 curricular review and faculty meetings. The

program should include any changes that are discussed at those meetings in the next annual report. The current report does mention small class sizes having better learning results, but does not expand on what data led them to this conclusion.

Response: The smaller class sizes were recommended to improve student learning experiences and are based on evidence:

Studies by Boyer et al. report student class size of approximately 30 students to be more beneficial for students than a larger class size because valuable educational approaches like active learning become viable (Boyer et al., 2007; Denton & McKinney, 2004). Kokkelenberg, Dillon and Christy (2008) examined the effect of class size on student performance in undergraduate students. They reported that student scores were higher in smaller classes (less than 20 students) but scores remained constant for classes with more than 20 students. A study on teachers' perspective on class size suggests that a factor to improve student learning outcomes should provide a class size reduction program to implement new strategies, pedagogically productive to smaller settings (Watson, Handal & Maher, 2017).

"...recommended that class size reduction programs should be implemented under the provision of new instructional strategies, pedagogically productive to smaller settings, are to be enacted."

Class sizes, traditionally bound by physical available space in the classroom is defined as very small (1to 10 students) small (11 to 20 students), medium (21 to 30 students), large (31 to 40 students) and very large (41 students and above).

(Burruss, Billings, Brownrigg, Skiba & Connors, 2009).

i. Methods of analysis of student achievement data identify successful student achievement of outcomes and associated strengths of curriculum and pedagogy

⊠Positive trend evident

The current report does mention small class sizes having better learning results, but does not expand on what data led them to this conclusion. Additionally, the report mentions current/teaching and learning mechanisms being effective, and they plan to continue. It's not clear what student learning data helped support this conclusion.

Response: Option coordinators have included the data that supports each conclusion.

j. Assessment data informs curricular, pedagogical, and other necessary changes.

The program does not identify any changes at this time, as this will be discussed at various meetings in August 2018.

The current report does mention small class sizes having better learning results, but does not expand on what data led them to this conclusion.

Response: Individual options have meetings to discuss specific curricular issues several times each semester. Major curricular changes are placed on the agenda for the Undergraduate and Pre-Licensure Program Committee (UPPC) meetings. Each proposal is discussed at length and voted on by the Program member faculty. Major workload review and revisions for 2019-20 will provide additional faculty satisfaction data as well as student satisfaction with more sections added to courses with smaller numbers of students. (study evidence included above and end of course evaluations) Narrative summative statements at end of each option report by each option coordinator are provided.
