# HAZWOPER AND DOT TRAINING

#### **40 HOUR HAZWOPER**

40 Hour HAZWOPER is a comprehensive course for **waste-site workers (as per 29 CFR 1910.120)**. This course is required for any individual who will be in clean-ups and related activities at an uncontrolled waste site.

#### **24 HOUR HAZWOPER**

24 Hour HAZWOPER is designed for **limited duty waste-site workers** and emergency responders (as per 29 CFR 1910.120(q)). This course will prepare personnel for specific on-site training. Emphasis is given to industrial emergency response situations.

#### WHAT IS DOT TRAINING?

Current U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) regulations require initial and recurrent training of all employees who perform work functions covered by the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR; 49 CFR Parts 171-180). Any employee whose work directly affects hazardous materials transportation safety is required to have training.

## **COURSE INFO**

CEET offers 40 and 24 hour HAZWOPER training every two months. The 8 hour annual HAZWOPER refresher is scheduled once every month.

DOT training for Air and Ground are provided three times a year and are provided on adjacent days for your convenience.
