HAZWOPER AND DOT TRAINING

40 HOUR HAZWOPER

40 Hour HAZWOPER is a comprehensive course for **waste-site workers (as per 29 CFR 1910.120)**. This course is required for any individual who will be in clean-ups and related activities at an uncontrolled waste site.

24 HOUR HAZWOPER

24 Hour HAZWOPER is designed for **limited duty waste-site workers and emergency responders (as per 29 CFR 1910.120(q))**. This course will prepare personnel for specific on-site training. Emphasis is given to industrial emergency response situations.

WHAT IS DOT TRAINING?

Current U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) regulations require initial and recurrent training of all employees who perform work functions covered by the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR; 49 CFR Parts 171-180). Any employee whose work directly affects hazardous materials transportation safety is required to have training.

COURSE INFO

CEET offers 40 and 24 hour HAZWOPER training every two months. The 8 hour annual HAZWOPER refresher is scheduled once every month.

DOT training for Air and Ground are provided three times a year and are provided on adjacent days for your convenience.
