

Limited Submission Opportunity

Beckman Scholars Program

Interested faculty are invited to apply to have a **Beckman Scholars Program**, sponsored by the Arnold and Mabel Beckman Foundation, at Saint Louis University. The Program is a 15-month mentored research experience for exceptional undergraduate students in chemistry, biological sciences, or interdisciplinary combinations thereof. The purpose of the Program is to help stimulate, encourage and support scientific research activities by full-time undergraduate students, under the guidance of a full-time, approved faculty member.

Overview of the Program

- This is an institutional award and SLU can submit one proposal for an award.
- If successful, the award duration is three years, and SLU can select two scholar-mentor pairs each year of the award.
- The program provides \$26,000 to each scholar-mentor pair: \$21,000 to the student and \$5,000 to the faculty mentor.
- Research activities must be performed part-time (ten hours per week) during one academic year, and full-time over two summers (ten 40-hour weeks each summer) immediately before and after the academic year research experience.
- Once selected, a student will retain the award for 15 months.
- Students must be full-time undergraduate students throughout the duration of the award.

Interested faculty should notify their interest to RDG at <u>rdg@slu.edu</u>, by no later than May 6, **2024**. Once interest has been established, SLU will select one faculty PI to apply to Beckman for a Beckman Scholars Program at SLU.

The application deadline to Beckman is **June 14, 2024**.
