The Award & Eligibility Criteria

The 2024 Camille Dreyfus Teacher-Scholar Awards Program supports the research and teaching careers of talented young faculty in the chemical sciences in departments that grant a doctoral degree. Based on institutional nominations, the program provides discretionary funding to faculty at an early stage in their careers.

Criteria for selection include an independent body of scholarship attained in the early years of their appointment, and a demonstrated commitment to education, signaling the promise of continuing outstanding contributions to both research and teaching.

The Award provides an unrestricted research grant of \$100,000.

Guidance for the Nomination Process

An internal competition will be held to assign the single slot. <u>Interested faculty should submit a</u> <u>1-2 page summary of their future research plans, and CV, through SLU's OpenWater portal by</u> <u>5pm on December 4, 2023: https://slu.secure-platform.com/a/solicitations/151/home</u>

A SLU faculty selection committee will review and select the most suitable applicant and notify all applicants of the outcome by December 15, 2023, barring any unforeseen circumstances. The Foundation's nomination deadline is February 1, 2024.
