



Missouri Voters' Opinions on Charter Schools

The following document summarizes the opinions of likely voters in Missouri on issues related to charter schools. These results are from SLU/YouGov Polls conducted from June 2020 to February 2024. The SLU/YouGov Poll is a biannual survey of likely Missouri voters aiming to inform policymakers, citizens, and researchers of Missourians' opinions on important issues facing the state.

Key Missouri Findings

- 52% of Missouri voters believe charter schools should be allowed to operate in their local district ([Aug. 2023 Poll](#))
- 55% of Missouri voters believe charter schools should be allowed to operate across the state ([Aug. 2023 Poll](#))
- Less than 40% of Missouri voters correctly identify Missouri charter schools as public schools ([June 2020 Poll](#))
