CONDITIONAL ADMISSION POLICY AGREEMENT**

The Saint Louis University School of Social Work Student Affairs Committee has reviewed your application and has determined that you can be admitted to the MSABA, Post Cert in ABA, MACCJ, MSUPD, or MSW Program with a conditional status. *The conditional period is over one (1) semester for a total of 6 program specific credit hours. All conditional students will not exceed six credit hours during the conditional semester and must also maintain a 3.0 GPA for the conditional semester. Please note that a “B-“ is below a 3.0.* (Non-native English speaking students may take the required Graduate level ESL course consecutively in addition to the 6 MSW credit hours.) Students on admission condition will follow all policies as outlined in the respective program handbook. ***If degree program requires practicum, students on condition can plan for practicum but will not be able to register for practicum until they are off conditional admission status.***

At the end of the conditional semester and the completion of six credit hours of course work, the Student Affairs Committee will review the student’s progress to determine whether the student will be removed from conditional status, continue on condition, or be dismissed from the program. In order to be removed from conditional status, the student must successfully complete one (1) semester for a total of 6 credit hours and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 for the semester. To determine whether the student has met conditional requirements, the student’s transcript(s) will be reviewed for a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above and, as needed, the Committee will consult with the student’s instructor(s), advisor, and support service personnel. If the applicant is given full admission to the enrolled program, credit for courses taken while on conditional status will be counted toward the student’s degree

As a conditional admit student you must fulfill the requirements described below:

- Enroll in two courses for the first semester
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 each semester of probationary status
- Successfully complete a series of 4 one-on-one consultations with University Writing Services (writing@slu.edu)
- Other requirements as determined by the Student Affairs Committee _____
